Incorporate best environmental practice in the growth of the business

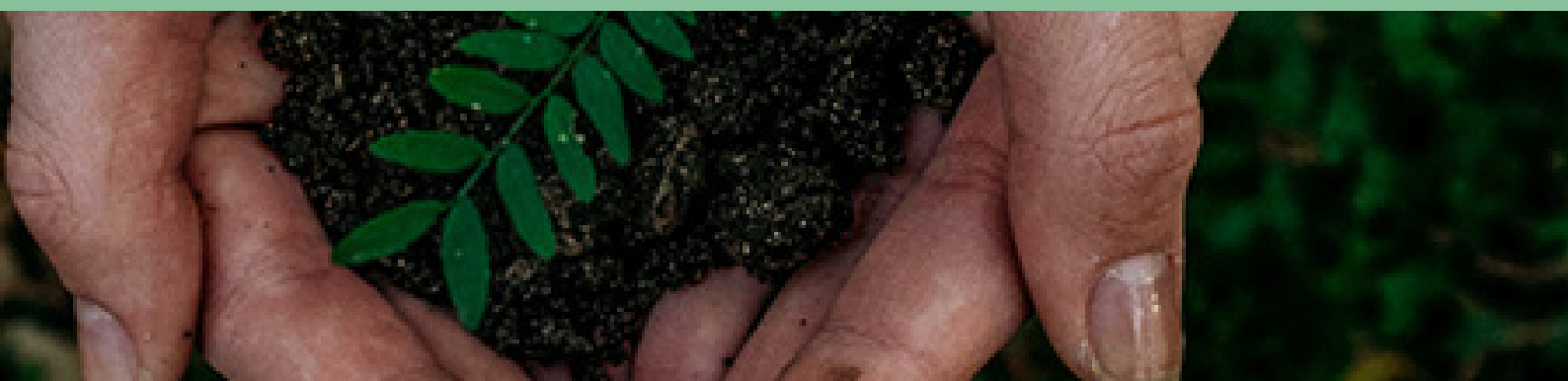
Work with others at local and national level to promote and develop environmental good practice
